Parent Volunteers (including Deck Parents) will receive a “deck pass” at check-in. It must be visible at all times.

There will be meetings on deck to cover your responsibilities. Please make sure you are on deck by 10:35, as some of these meetings start as early as 10:40.

DECK PARENT INFORMATION

- Team Area assignment will be given at check-in. Red and Blue teams will be seated together.
- We are only allowed 1 parent per 10 swimmers, so we are consolidating deck parents so that each parent is responsible for one Age Group and Gender.
- You will be responsible for both RED and BLUE team members in your age group. (i.e., 7-8 Girls Red and Blue will be the same parent- you will have both lists)
- Assistant coaches will also be available to help get the kids to the ready benches.
- Parent Alternates will be needed if our total number of qualifiers changes on Saturday after Divisionals. Check with Sandra Rago or Barbara Broughton to see whether you are needed.

Responsibilities:

1. Check in swimmers (both Red and Blue for your assigned age group), give them their Event/Heat/Lane information
2. Get the kids to their respective ready benches prior to their event and back to the team area (see notes below)
3. Keep the kids in our assigned area when they are not swimming. They can cheer on their friends from behind the blocks, they may not block access to the pool or obstruct officials.
4. Keep the kids out of the diving well during the meet unless they have prior experience using it for warm-up/cool down.

Notes for Swimmers and Deck Parents:

1. The large pool will be divided into two 25-yard pools.
2. Girls will swim in the North Pool (American Flag End)
3. Boys will swim in the South Pool (Texas Flag End)
4. The main pool is 9 feet deep, the diving well is 18 feet deep.
5. Boys and girls will be swimming at the same time, so you will go straight from boys event to boys event (2 then 4 then 6, etc.) or girls event to girls event.
6. Remember to get them to the ready bench EARLY, it goes faster than you think because it is every other event in the same pool.
7. 25-yard events will start from the Bulkhead at the center of the pool and swim towards the outside (towards the starting blocks). This is where the touchpads are.
8. 50-yard and 100-yard events will start from the starting blocks
9. Watch the scoreboard on either end for your name and time!

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR INVITATIONALS

The UT Swim Center is located on the University of Texas Campus, one block west of I-35 on the northwest corner at the intersection of Martin Luther King Boulevard and Red River Street.

PARKING: The C80 Surface lot will be open for \$5.00 per car. See map on page 4 for location. This is the closest, most convenient parking to the swim center. There is a parking garage across MLK blvd (Trinity Garage) and one next to the Soccer Stadium (Manor Garage) available for \$10 per day. State garages may also be available. Note the areas where you cannot park on the map (next page)

As you enter the Swim Center from the main entrance you will be on the 3rd level. Concessions are on the 2nd level. The pool Deck is on the 1st level. Swimmers and volunteers will need to go to the 1st level for check in and access to the pool deck. Spectator seating is in individual stadium-style chairs. Access to spectator seating is available on the 2nd and 3rd levels. Rest rooms are on the 2nd and 3rd levels.

As you choose your seats, remember:

Girls Heats will be held in the North Pool (American Flag end)

Boys Heats will be held in the South Pool (Texas Flag end)

Bring your own **heat sheets (including volunteers!)**, they will not be available at the Meet, and we will not have copies.

Swimmer names and times will be displayed on the scoreboards for each pool.
