Parents,

Our final session will be Thursday, July 3rd (tomorrow) and will be a red & blue meet. As such we will follow a different schedule for the day.

- 8:00 Set-up volunteers report to the pool for set up
- 9:00 All swimmers should be at the pool with the equipment listed below
- 9:10 Warm-Up begins for swimmers
- 9:30 Meet Starts
- 11:00 Awards Ceremony at the Park

The pool deck will be arranged differently for the meet. The ends of the pool and the far side of the pool will still be off limit to everyone except, swimmers, coaches and parents volunteering for the various jobs. (See job schedule below). All non working parents and siblings will be able to remain on the pool deck on the side of the pool closest to the gates. Feel free to bring chairs to set out to watch the meet if you like.

Swimmers should arrive slightly before 9:00 am with sunscreen already on. For this event it is wise to send a small bag/backpack with your swimmer to help them keep their gear together. This bag should contain. 2 towels, goggles, caps, a water bottle and possibly a small snack if you think they will get hungry between 9 and 11. If you send a snack please make sure it does not contain nuts and is not messy. We don't want sticky swimmers and we don't want any issues with peanut allergies.

We will have 4 areas set up for the swimmers. Swimmers should be taken to their tent area listed below based on their actual age not their practice group since this is how they will compet. Parents should return to the other side of the pool.

- Covered picnic area – Girls & Boys 8 - 10
- Trellis covered picnic area – Girls & Boys 7 yrs old
- Tent on the right – Girls & Boys 6 yrs old
- Tent on the left – Girls & Boys 5 yrs old

The following events will be swum during the meet. Most events will have multiple heats. A heat ribbon will be awarded to the winner of each heat. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbons will be awarded for each event and will be placed in an envelop which will be given to your swimmer at the Awards Ceremony along with session picture and swimming medal. Coach Karen will give all of this out during the ceremony. We will not have copies available at the pool that morning so please make sure to print it.

After the completion of the last event, parents should collect their swimmers from their tents making sure they have taken everything they brought with them. At that time everyone is invited to join us in the park for a celebration with cake and beverages. Awards will begin about 15 – 20 minutes after the completion of the meet. Any parents who have free hands after the meet are asked to help with putting the pool deck back to normal so we can be out for the rest of the neighborhood to enjoy the pool.

If you have enjoyed your time with the stars, please make sure to let the HOA know and express your appreciation. They worked hard to re-arrange summer pool schedules to make this program happen. Also, please look for a swim survey coming out later this summer via the HOA website. We will e-mail you when it is available. The Stars and the HOA will be working this fall to determine how best to serve the needs of the community from a swim program perspective.
